Provide educational opportunities for district residents of all ages – educational, recreational, social and cultural programs.

Personnel

- Two Community Education Coordinators
- 1 part-time support staff (secretary)
- Over 150 instructors; fluctuates based on season, course offerings, etc.

Location: District office - in the windowed walkway between the district office and high school white building.

Programs held in all district facilities – five elementary schools, the middle school and high school, and some off-site locations (i.e. Rum River BMX Track, A Place for the Birds, Lexington Memorial Park, SMW Credit Union, Wargo Nature Center, a farm in Red Wing, Chomonix Golf Course, Dance Moves) in order to enhance the learning experience for participants. Also hold seasonal field trips on and off site.

2008-2009 enrollment

- Just over 4,800 participants
- 81 percent are youth and 19 percent are adults
