BUILDINGS

SCHEDULED: Eight - high school campus (two buildings), middle school, five elementary schools

CLIENTS: 168 including schools and school groups (parent organizations, community education), and resident groups (parent-run athletic associations, city elections, city park and recreation departments, homeowner associations), individual residents, and outside agencies (colleges/universities).

HOURS OF USE:

20,000+ after school, evening and weekend activities in 2008-09 school year. Summer use is also scheduled.

PERMITS

ISSUED: Over 1,180 permits were issued in the 2008-09 school year.

INDIVIDUALS

SERVED: 25,250 per year (2008-09)

FUNDING: Supported by client fees.

CHALLENGES: Lack of sufficient gym space to meet demand, especially on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

ITEMS TO NOTE:

- Meet quarterly with facility use staff from other districts.
- Review and propose changes in Policy 2060 and fee structure every other year.
- Attend district youth group board meetings for open discussion on how district facilities are used by their group.
