DRIVERS EDUCATION BEHIND-THE-WHEEL

This phase of driver education consists of a 6 day driving experience with student and partner in the car 2 hours each day, totaling 6 hours of driving and 6 of observation. Both driving and observation are equally important parts of the program. Classes begin at 8 a.m. and go in 2-hour blocks until 6 or 8p.m. (8-10a.m., 10a.m.-12p.m. 12-2p.m., etc). Meet in front of the high school white building. Students provide their own transportation to and from class.

Cost: \$209 full payment or 2 payments \$104.50 at registration and a second payment of \$104.50 on or before June 1 (partial payments can not be made online). Registration is on a first come, first serve basis.

NOTE: Students do not need to have completed or even started the CLASSROOM phase to register for BEHIND-THE-WHEEL. As long as students are enrolled in a classroom session, they can register for behind-the-wheel. Registering for BEHIND-THE-WHEEL allows students to get their permit as soon as they pass the classroom phase and are at least 15. Registering early also gives students the best chance of getting the time slot that fits their schedule.
