Summer Kids Club CAMP 2016 Registration is underway:

Registrations are being accepted online through [FeePay](#) or via printed contracts available on the District website. Enrollments received by May 1 are guaranteed summer care. After May 1, enrollments will be accepted if space allows, and the registration fee will increase from \$25 to \$50 per child. Summer sites are Blue Heron Elementary and Rice Lake Elementary. Kids Club 2016-17 Registration:

Enrollment for next school year will be accepted online through FeePay or via printed contracts available on the District website beginning May 15. Enrollments received in the Kids Club’s main office by June 30 will be guaranteed care. Enrollments will be accepted, from July 1 to August 15 if space allows and the registration fee will increase from \$25 to \$50 per child. Fall registration will be **CLOSED from August 16-September 15 for a September 6-16 start date**. If space allows, registrations for a start date of September 19 through the end of the school year will be accepted at the \$25 registration fee.



Billing Reminder:


Payments are due the 23rd of each month for the current month. Accounts not paid on time will be assessed a \$20 late fee. If payment isn’t received by the 1st of the month, suspension will occur. Parents receive an electronic invoice from [FeePay](#), the online registration/billing system, at the beginning of each month via the email provided in your registration materials. For families that have set up Auto Pay, payments are automatically paid on the 23rd of each month using the account specified.

Procedure Reminder on Reporting Absences:

If your child is going to be absent, please notify your child’s Kids Club staff directly. **Do not call or email attendance information to the Kids Club Registration/Billing Secretary.** Additionally, parents must report absences to their school 24-hour attendance line. Please understand school office staff do not notify Kids Club staff when a child leaves early or is absent for the day.

April 4 & 25 Non-School Days:

On April 4, we will remain on-site while *The Teaching Juggler*, Mike Monson, comes out to put on a show and also allow children to “play with the toys.” The **deadline to enroll has passed, however, a limited number of drop ins are available for \$60. On April 25, we will remain on-site while Kids Club staff provide a variety of science activities in addition to our normal on-site activities of crafts, gym, outside, computer, and games. Deadline to enroll at the \$36/day rate is Tuesday April 5.** Register using FeePay.
