**FREE confidential, individual tutoring and classes, designed for adults age 17 and older, that are learner centered and self-paced.**

→ **Basic skills refresher**

Help to review and improve skills in reading, writing and math by a licensed teacher. These skills help prepare for getting a job or promotion, entering post-secondary education and are strongly connected to earning power.

→ **General Education Development (GED) Preparation**

The GED is a set of tests that when passed, certify the test taker has met high school level academic skills. The ACE program assists students in preparing for the GED with:

- Assistance in earning an age waiver for learners under age 19.
- Tutoring and classes with easy to understand texts, workbooks and GED computer programs
- Information and guidance about content and grading through the online GED test
- Encouragement and confidence
- A public graduation ceremony complete with cap, gown, pomp and circumstance

→ **Accuplacer Preparation**

Brush up and practice tests for preparing to take the college or technical school placement test, Accuplacer.

→ **Online College Preparation**

Mindquest Academy offers 22 courses in career development, and building skills for success in college. Study in class or at home and email assignments to a state certified teacher.
