

PBIS Spin the Wheel Prize Guidelines

Each prize on the wheel is somewhat self-explanatory. However, consistency is necessary so that there aren't significant differences in how multiple classrooms celebrate the same prize.

Take for example "gameday." One teacher may want to allow their students to bring games from home, another might just prefer to use games in the classroom. Are students allowed to play games for 30 minutes? One hour? More? Less?

Please see guidelines below. As we become more familiar with PBIS we can modify our prizes and guidelines.

★ Ice Cream Party

- The winning classroom enjoys ice cream with delicious toppings in their classroom (or the cafeteria). The teacher purchases the ice cream, toppings, bowls and spoons. Shop at Walmart - it's much simpler because we have a Walmart Credit Card for CTE. If not Walmart, the teacher will be reimbursed.

★ Movie

- The winning classroom enjoys a movie chosen by their teacher in the little theater. The kids will be served popcorn during the movie.
- Teacher selects an appropriate movie title. Check <https://www.commonsemmedia.org/> to check appropriateness of any movie. G-rated movies are usually fine, if teacher shows a PG-rated movie, they must inform their parents of the title and give them an opt-out opportunity. Teachers will be reimbursed for the cost of the rental. Public libraries have tons of DVD's for free!

★ Fine Dining

- The winning classroom will enjoy a fine dining experience during lunch, complete with table cloth, fancy place settings, and dessert served by their teacher (and other staff available to help out).

★ Artist in Residence

- Winning class will get a special art lesson in classroom taught by a guest art teacher.
- Purchase supplies at Walmart with our credit card, or cost of supplies will be reimbursed.

★ Game Day

- The winning classroom will get to bring in board games from home to play with classmates in their classroom. 1 hour maximum game time.
- ★ Students vs. Staff
 - The winning class will get to play a game in the gym or outside against staff members (volleyball, soccer, basketball hoops competition, tag, other ideas from Jen V., etc)
 - The rest of the grade level will be invited to cheer on their schoolmates.
- ★ Tech Time
 - Each winning classroom teacher can decide what extra tech time is appropriate for your class depending on your grade level
 - iPads
 - Extra computer lab time
 - Make a movie on a Chromebook
 - Explore a cool app
- ★ Class Choice
 - Winning class votes on one of the above
 - Majority wins
