With the exception of students, each term is three years in length.

Responsibilities

- Review and provide input on all aspects of curriculum, instruction and assessment
- Review students' progress toward meeting graduation standards and examine the strengths and weaknesses of instruction and curriculum affecting students' progress
- Provide input on programs & initiatives designed to improve student learning
- Provide recommendations to the School Board to curriculum, instruction and assessment

The Systems Accountability Committee (SAC) typically meets four times during the school year. Agendas will be provided to committee members in advance of each meeting.
