Welcome to School Readiness Preschool!

The Centennial School District offers School Readiness Preschool to children who will be three and four years of age by September 1, 2019. The goal of School Readiness Preschool is to help preschoolers enter kindergarten with the skills and behaviors necessary to be successful learners.

The concept of “school readiness” includes both academic skills such as literacy, math, science, and art, and social/emotional skills such as listening, following directions, sharing, and problem solving. Our classes are taught by licensed teachers using play-based curriculum and assessment tools approved by the State of Minnesota. Our preschool has earned a 4-Star Parent Aware Rating.

It is a priority of School Readiness Preschool to involve parents in their child’s education. Research has shown that early childhood programs that involve parents and children learning together are more effective than programs that focus only on the child. **Each class requires that a parent or caregiver attend regularly.** Parent days are noted in the class listings.

All students must be potty trained and able to use the bathroom independently.

All classes are held at the Early Childhood Center located at Rice Lake Elementary. School Readiness Preschool follows the Centennial School District calendar, including late-start and no school days.

Before and After School Care

The full-day School Readiness Preschool classes may be combined with before and/or after school care through KC Preschool's enrichment program. Care can be contracted on a regular or drop-in basis. Space is limited. Note that charges below are in addition to preschool tuition, and there is a \$35 registration fee.

Annual tuition is divided into nine monthly payments, invoiced August through April. A **\$25 non-refundable registration fee** is charged when your student is placed in a class. If your contract is approved at Scale B or C you will be required to complete an Application for Reduced Tuition.

Financial Assistance

If a family situation is limiting the possibility of your child enrolling in School Readiness Preschool, please call the program coordinator at 763-792-6122 to discuss options. We offer scholarships and tuition reductions to ensure that all families have access to a high-quality preschool experience.

How to Register

Registration is online at isd12.ce.eleyo.com. You will need to create an account in order to register. (If you have taken an ECFE course, completed Early Childhood Screening, or signed up for a Community Education program, you already have an Eleyo account.) If you do not have online access you may register by phone or in person. Call 763-792-6120 for more information.

Registration opens January 15. Completing a registration generates a pending contract and does not guarantee placement in a class. Contracts will be approved in the order received. However, if there is not sufficient space to place all interested families, priority will be given to children with demonstrated need based on household criteria. The \$25 registration fee is charged only if your contract is approved. Contract approvals will begin February 15; you will be notified by email.

You should register for your first choice class. You will be asked for optional second and third choices during the registration process. Only one registration per child will be accepted. If you are registering more than one child you must register them separately, even if you are registering them for the same class.

You will be asked about optional sibling care or before/after school care as part of the registration process, but these contracts will not be initiated until after a preschool contract is approved.

If you do not receive a confirmation email after registering, your contract request was not successful. Please log in again and review your registration to make sure you have provided all required information.

Other Preschool Options

Looking for a 5-day-a-week option? KC Preschool is a full-day, fee-based, year-before-kindergarten program offered at each of the elementary schools in the Centennial School District. KC Preschool offers 2-, 3-, and 5-day schedules, with priority given to 5-day students. Enrollment begins January 15, 2019. See isd12.org/community-education/kc-preschool or call 763-792-6111 for more information.

Not sure if your child is ready for an independent preschool experience? Consider Early Childhood Family Education's Parents & Preschoolers class. Intended for children from age 2-1/2 to 5, this class provides some of the structures and content of the preschool curriculum but a parent or caregiver attends each class with the child. Registration for this class takes place in May 2019. See isd12.org/ecfe or call 763-792-6120 for more information.

Early Childhood Screening

Early Childhood Screening is a free check of a child's growth and development. At your screening appointment, trained professionals check your child's hearing and vision, weight and height, health history, immunizations, speech and language, general development, and motor skills. Screening is NOT a readiness test for kindergarten. Screening can detect possible learning or health concerns so that a child can get help, if necessary, before starting school.

Centennial School District offers screenings once a month, October through May. Registration link and more information at isd12.org/schools/early-childhood/early-childhood-screening or by phone at 763-792-6120.

If our screening schedule does not work for you, Early Childhood Screening can be completed by another Minnesota school district, the Head Start program, the department of Public Health, or some health care providers. If your child is screened elsewhere, please be sure to forward a copy of the screening summary to Centennial ECFE.

Early Childhood Family Education Classes

Do you have younger children? Early Childhood Family Education (ECFE) offers weekly classes for children from birth to age 5 with a parent or caregiver. Both daytime and evening classes are available.
