Two Centennial Students Nominated for “Triple A” Award for Excellence in Academics, Arts and Athletics

January 8, 2014 (Circle Pines, MN)— **David McGough** and **Jill Conrad**, Centennial High School seniors, have been nominated for the Minnesota State High School League (MSHSL) Academics, Arts and Athletics Award (Triple A), School Activities Director Brian Hegseth announced today.

Established in 1988, the Triple A Award acknowledges a male and female high school senior with a 3.0 GPA, or higher, who participates in athletics, fine arts, theater, speech and music. Both McGough and Conrad are participants in a variety of programs at Centennial High School and in our community.

McGough’s awards and activities at Centennial include Captain and All-Conference Honorable Mention (2 years), Soccer; Captain, Boys Swimming; Captain, Boys Lacrosse; Concert and A Capella Choirs; Solo/Ensemble Superior; Fall Musical; Peer Leader; Elementary Mentor.

Conrad’s awards and activities at Centennial include National Honor Society; Captain, All-Conference Honorable Mention, State Tournament 2010, Volleyball; Captain and All-Conference (3 years), Basketball; Concert and A Capella Choirs; Solo/Ensemble Superior; Peer Leader.

The MSHSL’s Administrative Regions will review the Triple A nominees from its member schools. Centennial is in Region 5AA and will compete with 16 other schools. The top male and female students, as determined by a points system, will be invited to a banquet in March where MSHSL officials will announce the state-wide winners.
