Need, Question, Issue

What special programs and education are available to Native American students?

POLICY STATEMENT

School District #12 recognizes the contributions and unique needs of Indian students. The School Board directs the Superintendent of Schools/Superintendent’s designee to develop and implement educational programs and services that meet the needs of Native American students within budgetary constraints.

Rules and Procedures

- A. Native American Parent Advisory Committee will be established pursuant to Federal Regulations pertaining to the Indian Education Act Title IX.
- B. The Indian Education Parent Advisory Committee shall exist to promote Native American parental involvement in the education of Native American children enrolled in Centennial School District No. 12.
- C. The Parent Advisory Committee (PAC) and the Indian Education Act provides a framework to build a partnership of cooperation between the PAC and the school district.
- D. Centennial School District No. 12 shall apply for Title IX funding to meet the special educational and culturally related academic needs of the district’s Native American children for so long as these funds are available.
- E. Personnel hired through Title IX funding shall be employees of Centennial School District No. 12 and will act as the district’s liaison to the Parent Advisory Committee.
